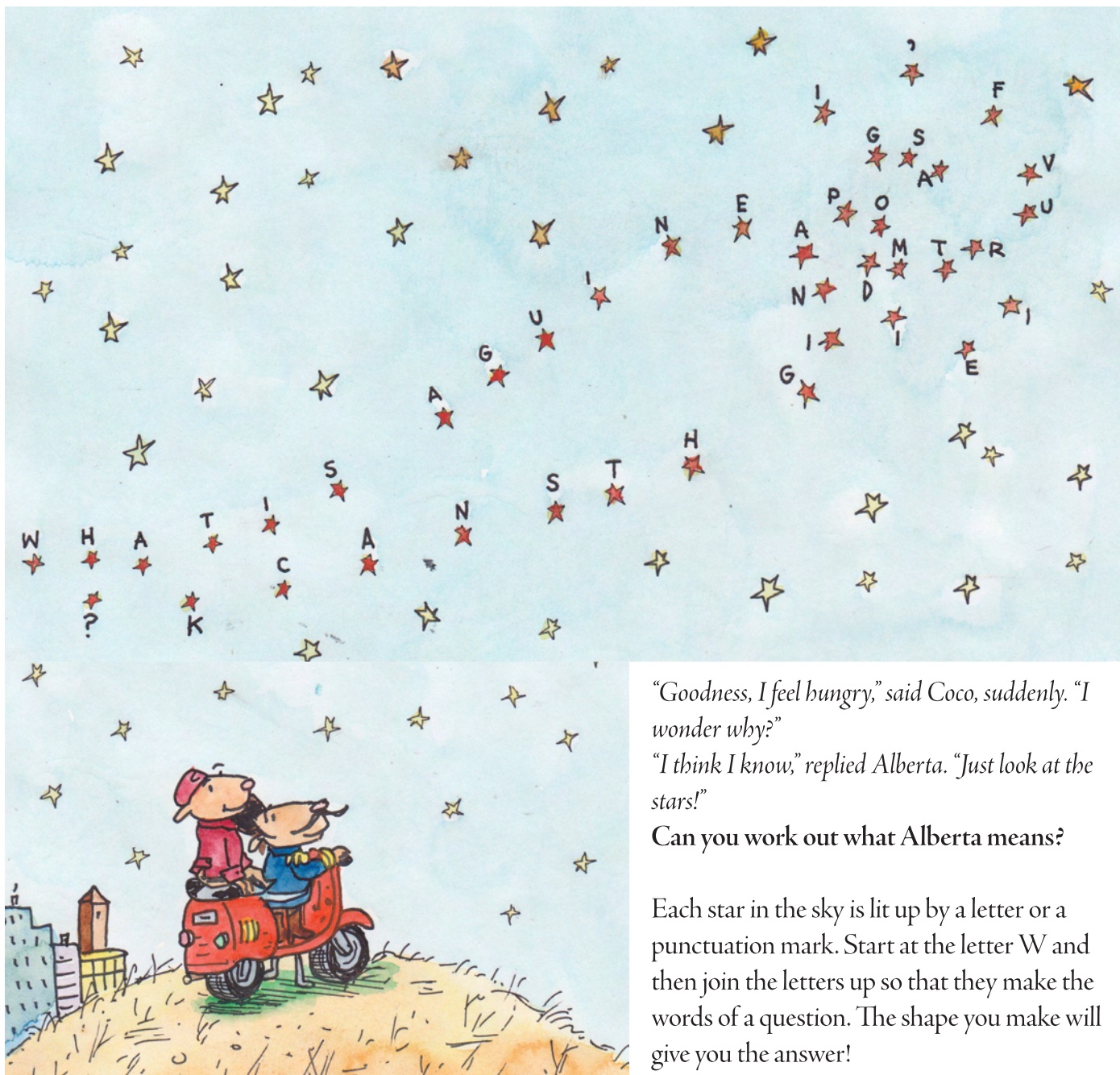


The Cryptic Casebook of **Coco Carlomagno** (and Alberta)
